### **Sonoran Conservancy of Fountain Hills is wrapping up its season and looking forward to kicking off the fall program this November.**

Sonoran Conservancy of Fountain Hills is wrapping up its season as the weather heats up.

The club will be back with its fall program this November, according to a press release.

In the 2025-26 season, SCFH volunteers worked for approximately 8,728 hours. The club went on 74 hikes with a total of 795 participants.

SCFH also hosted and welcomed visitors at Adero Canyon Trailhead for 118 days. A total of 51 active Trailblazers worked on all the Fountain Hills trails over the course of the season as well.

In the press release, SCFH advised those who are hiking during the summer to only hike short distances and to hydrate, avoid peak temperatures, wear sunscreen and

protective clothing and more. Options for short summer hikes include the Overlook Trail, the Promenade Trail and the Andrews-Kinsey Trail.

Registration for the fall hikes begins in August.
